 NOTE: Youth members (under age 18), sign as indicated. A parent or legal guardian must ALSO sign all three places.
- 4. Initial and sign at the bottom of page 2 of this sheet to acknowledge that you have read and agree.
- 5. Tear off and keep the last page titled "Welcome to the Greater Houston Soaring Association".
- 6. Pay the FULL initial fee with your application. If you fly the same day you join, you must also pay for the day's flights, at member rates.

Special notes

Only "Non-Rated Member" and "Transition Pilot" members receive flight training manuals. "Family" members receive only a log book. NO OTHER categories receive manuals or logbooks.

If you pay for an introductory flight and then join on the same weekend, your account will be adjusted to account for the reduced member flight rates.

Your initial fee includes the first month of GHSA dues and the first year of SSA dues.

Monthly dues are billed on the last day of the month and apply to the following month. Flight charges are for the month just ended.

You can expect to receive a monthly statement, either as an email attachment or via the US Mail, in the first week of each month unless you have a zero balance. If you do not receive your statement, please contact the Treasurer.

If you decide to leave GHSA, please let the Treasurer know. You need not give a reason if you don't want to, but ignoring your statements and simply stopping paying your dues creates ill will and extra workload for all concerned.

Billing information

Checks, either personal or through your bank's "bill pay" application, are preferred, payable to Greater Houston Soaring Association, or simply "GHSA". Our billing address is at the top of your statement.

If you wish to use a credit card AFTER your initial new-membership payment, we will add a 4% fee to cover our bank fees. If the dispatcher who accepts your card fails to add the fee, it will be added to your account by the Treasurer.

A note concerning your financial obligations:

We hope the following is never necessary, but unfortunately it is for the occasional member.

Like any business or household, GHSA cannot operate without cash flow -- meaning regular payment of members' accounts. If you are unable to meet your obligations, it is YOUR responsibility to contact the Treasurer or any other Board member. We are always open to working out a plan with you.

In the absence of an agreement, you will be barred from scheduling any lesson, flying any club ship, or receiving a tow by any GHSA tow plane until you pay your balance in full if either of the following applies:

- 1. If any regular monthly statement indicates a balance in excess of \$800 -- or --
- 2. Three month-end billing cycles pass without payment.

Additionally, if six billing cycles pass without payment, your membership may be canceled, and to reinstate, you will be required to pay the full balance of your most recent statement PLUS an additional new-member fee for your category of membership.

And finally: GHSA is not a flight school or a fixed-base glider rental operation. We are a non-profit organization and have no paid employees -- all members volunteer their time. If we want to fly, someone must volunteer to run operations. If <u>you</u> want to fly, someone has to volunteer. If you are unwilling or unable to contribute in some manner - as ground safety crew, tow pilot, dispatcher, or whatever, this likely is not the organization for you.

Just a few items that you might find helpful:

Your Monthly Volunteer Duty — it's easy to sign up on our online schedule

The way to do it is:

Go to our website: www.houstonsoaring.org

Click on "Members"

Enter password and click on the arrow to the right (Please ask the dispatcher for the current password.)

Edit the spreadsheet appropriately and responsibly

You have from the 1st to the 15th of a month to choose a duty date in the following month. For example, from August 1-15 select and schedule a day in September; from September 1-15 select and schedule a day in October; from October 1-15 select and schedule a day in November.

If an open day does not fit in your schedule, then it is your responsibility to **exchange** a day with someone on the schedule. It is important that you **NEVER CHANGE OR EXCHANGE A NAME ON THE SCHEDULE WITHOUT TALKING TO THAT PERSON FIRST.**

You can also volunteer as far ahead as you want. You are not restricted to the month being scheduled.

When you arrive at the gliderport for your Duty Day, report to the dispatcher. Be sure to sign in on the Weekend Volunteer Sign-in Sheet so that your name is entered in the drawing for a free tow at the Monthly General Membership Meeting.

Thanks to those who come out and work on their scheduled Duty Day! It is because of all of our member/volunteers that our operations continue to run smoothly.

Monthly General Membership Meeting

Our Monthly General Membership Meeting is held in the Aviation Center on the 1st Saturday of each month, usually at 9:00 a.m., but times may vary. A monthly email will confirm the time. We discuss issues, hear the current state of our financials, have an educational presentation, draw for the "volunteer" free tows, and hangar fly, and if the weather is flyable, go outside and actually fly.

Monthly Statement and Newsletter

Your monthly statement will be emailed to you. If you do not have email access, please contact the Treasurer. Your balance due may be mailed to the Treasurer by the 25th of each month or you may leave it with the dispatcher at the gliderport. Billing address is at the top of your statement. We accept cash, checks, MasterCard and Visa (plus 4% for cards).

Scheduling Your Flights

We start scheduling for the weekend on the Monday prior to that Saturday and/or Sunday. Just call the number listed on our online schedule (979-398-5827). For a lesson, you will be scheduled for 1-1 ½ hours with the instructor (CFIG). Monthly ground school is free. Cost for flights is only for the tow plus glider rental. Licensed pilots may schedule a club ship in the same manner.

One of the benefits of membership is that you may bring your family and friends and their flight is at your member rates (rather than introductory rates). Just call the scheduling number listed on our online schedule (979-398-5827).

On the day of the flight, be sure that all visitors (including family and friends) complete the Introductory Membership form (same as intros) before flying. This is required by our insurance carrier. The forms are in the notebook with the dispatcher.
